
## Assisted dying and non-assisted suicide



Non-assisted suicides in <u>Oregon</u> have risen by one third, despite legalising assisted dying <sup>1, 2</sup>

In 2022, only 3 patients in Oregon were referred for psychiatric evaluation <sup>3</sup>






In <u>Europe</u> suicide rates have not decreased after the legalisation of assisted dying.<sup>4</sup> <u>Dutch</u> non-assisted suicides have increased compared with Germany.<sup>4</sup> <u>Belgium</u> now has the highest non-assisted suicide rate in women in Europe.<sup>4</sup>

In <u>Canada</u> non-assisted suicide rates increased 2016-19 (11-12.2/100k) then reduced in 2020 (10.1/100k) <sup>5</sup>



In <u>UK</u> data confirms previous work that the risk of suicide is highest in the year after diagnosis, then the risk reduces.<sup>6</sup> Suicide prevention is key.
