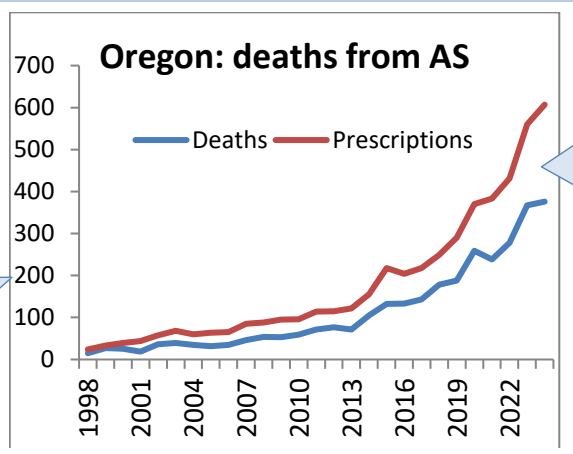


The reality of medically assisted dying in Oregon (updated to 2024)<sup>1</sup>



Assisted deaths have more than quadrupled in the last 10 years<sup>1</sup>



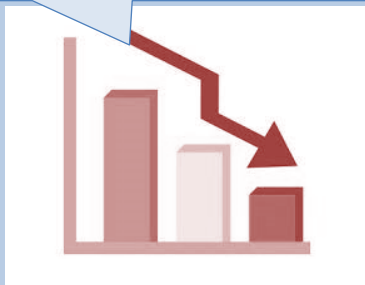
In 2024 16% did not use their prescriptions.

A further 29% died, but there is no information on whether they took their lethal drugs.

In 2024, 42% felt being a burden was a reason for requesting an assisted death compared with 12% in 1998<sup>2</sup>



The US is 43<sup>rd</sup> in end-of-life care rankings (↓34 places since 2015)<sup>3, 4</sup>

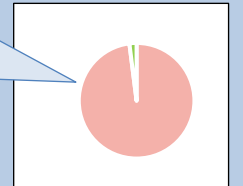


In 2024, death took more than 53mins in half, taking up to 26 hours, but data missing in 68%<sup>1</sup>

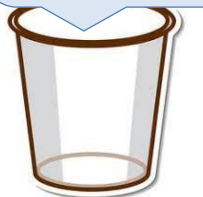
Drug cocktails of 4-5 drugs used. On their 4<sup>th</sup> mixture in 8yrs which have caused prolonged deaths<sup>1</sup>



Less than 2% of Oregon doctors prescribe (one wrote 84 prescriptions).



Only 13% of assisted deaths had seen a specialist palliative care team<sup>5</sup>



in 2012, 66% of hospices did not allow staff to take part in assisted deaths<sup>6</sup>



Much official information is missing such as 68% of data on complications<sup>1</sup>  
Source material is destroyed 1yr after death<sup>7</sup>

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
